

Considering 2018 has been declared as Another Year of Delivery, we have made substantial progress, as we entered the second phase of our Building Opportunities, Living Dreams 2025 (BOLD2025) Strategic Plan. This supports the continued growth and development of UNITEN and it charts the course for realizing our aim to become a Globally Competitive – Energy Focused University by 2025. At the forefront of UNITEN's transformation wave, we are proud to witness the commencement of construction works on our new RM120 million state-of-the-art open multidisciplinary laboratory at the heart of the campus. This is indeed an exciting time for UNITEN. The University is rapidly growing with significant upgrading works which provide further world-class facilities for students and staff.

UNITEN offers industry-driven and outstanding education at affordable cost. Currently, UNITEN holds a total number of 9,161 students studying in the fields and programmes of their choice from foundation, diploma, degree, masters to PhD level. Besides being accredited by local professional bodies, our academic programmes are also accredited by international professional bodies. Strong university-industry linkages would be an added advantage for our students to gain valuable experiences working with experts during their industrial training at our parent company, Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB), the biggest utility company in Southeast Asia. Students also benefit through international exchange programmes, career development programmes and extensive student development activities. This is further amplified by the dedication and hard work of our staff in broadening research collaborations with industry contributing to the creation of a vibrant academic learning community specifically tailoring the need of Malaysia Electricity Supply Industry (MESI).

For the immediate future, we have our sights firmly set on growing UNITEN Endowment Fund Ecosystem comprising Yayasan Canselor UNITEN (YCU), Tabung Amanah Zakat UNITEN (TAZU), Alumni Endowment Fund (ALEF) and Dana Wakaf Ilmu UNITEN (DWIU) which aims to ensure long-term financial sustainability of this institution. Realising the importance of endowment in attracting and retaining best and brightest students as well as expanding our academic programmes and research efforts, UNITEN is determined to raise cumulative endowment funds worth of RM104 million by 2025. UNITEN international reputation continued to advance as we are proud to announce that UNITEN is ranked at #171 in the Times Higher Education (THE) Asia University Rankings 2018 from more than 12,000 universities in Asia (Top 1.5% in Asia), while being ranked #7 among Malaysian universities. Our Engineering, Computer Science and Information Technology programmes are also ranked at #255 in the 2018 Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings by Subject: Engineering and Technology, while being ranked #8 among Malaysian universities. UNITEN is also ranked #159 in the world in the THE Emerging Economies World University Rankings 2018, and Top 250 in the world in the THE Young University Rankings 2018 for universities under 50 years of age.

UNITEN achievements are grounded on the dedication and leadership of our staff, students and alumni communities. Our progress is also attributed to the diligence and expertise of our Board of Directors, and I would like to acknowledge and thank Board members for their continuous support and commitment. UNIVERSITY IN BRIEF











UNITEN was first established in 1997 as one of the subsidiaries of TNB, a utility conglomerate in Southeast Asia. In support of its parent company's aspiration, UNITEN has forged a strong connection with the industry in order to prepare professional graduates which will eventually upgrade the university's reputation as the leading global energy university by 2025. UNITEN believes that every student has the potential to bloom. Hence, the university is very critical in moulding quality graduates in the field of engineering, information technology, computer science and business management. Apart from academic achievement, UNITEN strives to develop holistic students who also possess the soft skills employers look for.

OUR TEACHING AND LEARNING ASPECT

UNITEN has two campuses which are Putrajaya Campus located in Selangor and Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah Campus (KSHAS) located in Pahang. It caters students who seek knowledge in different programme such as Foundation, Diploma, Bachelor's Degree, Masters and PhD. UNITEN has been equipping its graduates with necessary skills and practical knowledge to help them facing the real working-life in the near future.

The courses at UNITEN are certified by the Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA). The engineering courses are also accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Council Malaysia (EAC). Besides, the engineering and accounting courses are recognised by professional bodies which include the Board of Engineer Malaysia (BEM), the Institution of Mechanical Engineers (IMechE), the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (IEEE), the Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE), the Malaysia Institute of Accountants (MIA), the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW), and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA).

UNITEN keeps updating and upgrading its academic and infrastructure to meet the demands and needs of today's market. Hence, the latest development of UNITEN can be seen through its first Energy Sphere which was launched in December 2018. The Energy Sphere is a shared resource for advance training for postgraduate level in UNITEN, which is multidisciplinary in nature, especially those focusing on the energy sector. It also serves as an important role which integrates a variety of relevant disciplines such as teaching, research and consultation under all institutions in UNITEN. The development of this laboratory is in line with its BOLD2025 Strategic Plan.

OUR RESEARCH

UNITEN researchers have been contributing to the UNITEN community, specifically, and the local community, generally, through their studies. This is aligned with UNITEN's aim which is to develop the spirit of giving back to the community. At this university, the graduates are also expected to produce quality research, guided and facilitated by the experts – lecturers.

UNITEN operates several research institutes namely Innovation & Research Management Centre (iRMC), Institute of Power Engineering (IPE), Institute of Sustainable Energy (ISE), Institute of Energy Policy & Research (IEPRe), Institute of Informatics & Computing in Energy (IICE), and Institute of Energy Infrastructure (IEI). This is an indication that UNITEN is not only committed to producing industry-driven graduates but also scientific research.


OUR REPUTATION


Over the past years, the world has seen the stunning transformation of UNITEN in pursuit of academic excellence which has improved its reputation. Being granted 5 Star (Excellent) in the Rating System for Higher Education Institutions in Malaysia (SETARA) 2017, UNITEN has successfully positioned itself as a globally competitive energy-focused university. SETARA is a rating mechanism to measure the performance of undergraduate teaching and learning in universities and university colleges in Malaysia. UNITEN has also been granted Self-Accreditation Status which serves as a testament of a reliable quality assurance system is in place within UNITEN to systematically review its own academic programmes. Apart from that, obtaining this Self-Accreditation Status implies the empowerment and trust laid upon UNITEN by MQA to certify its own courses.

In 2018, UNITEN ranked 243 in the QS Asian University Rankings. UNITEN also ranked 255 in the QS World University Rankings by Subject in Engineering and Technology. In the THE World University Rankings, UNITEN was placed 801 – 1000. Besides, the university emerged for the first time in the THE Young University Ranking (World) and THE Emerging Economies University Rankings (World) which placed the university 201 – 250 and 159 respectively. Under the Webometric ranking system, UNITEN was ranked first among private institutions in Malaysia and ninth among universities in Malaysia.



▼ 2018 ANOTHER YEAR OF DELIVERY

2018 had been a great year for UNITEN to do its level best for the betterment of the University in addressing the overall scenario in the educational sector within Malaysia in relation to the number of new student intake. Concentrated efforts by intensive marketing and provision of scholarships and financial assistance have helped to improve the intake number in 2018. The international students' composition has also increased to 6% compared to previous year.

With the implementation of BOLD2025 Strategic Plan Phase 1, UNITEN has accomplished:

- Graduates' employability rate of 94% based on the Tracer Study conducted by Ministry of Higher Education in 2018. 6% of UNITEN graduates are entrepreneurs and job creators.
- Upgrading of UNITEN facilities including teaching and learning facilities, student apartments and 10Gbps internet access for both Putrajaya Campus and KSHAS.
 The open lab project has also commenced in 2018.
- Recruitment of eight world class professors through the Strategic Hires initiative for talent development of UNITEN staff. Research partnerships were forged with Imperial College, Oxford Institute for Energy Studies, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Sheffield University and The Institute of Energy Economics, Japan (IEEJ). This resulted in three collaborative research programmes with high profile institutions.
- Accumulation of endowment fund totalling RM72 million since year 2016 to date.
 Under BOLD2025 Strategic Plan, target of cumulative endowment is RM 104 million by the year 2025.
- UNITEN has also improved its ranking in the QS Asian Rankings 2018 at #243 and QS World Rankings by Subject 2018 (for Electrical & Electronic Engineering) at #255.


ANNUAL REPORT 2018






Public Lecture - Resilient and Smart Power Grid for Reliable and Sustainable Operations


As the charity and investment arm of UNITEN, Yayasan Canselor Universiti Tenaga Nasional (YCU) is committed to developing the nation, one step at a time, through its contribution to society by improving the socio-economy, especially through high impact research and high quality education. All contributions or donations to YCU are tax deductible under Section 44 (6) of Income Tax Act 1967.

YCU managed to raise RM2,677,686.00 for the year 2018. RM975,013.00 was spent in the same year. The pool of fund is collected mainly from philanthropies and corporate companies, via YCU annual events such as YCU Endowment Fundraising Dinner and YCU Charity Golf Tournament. A monthly salary deduction scheme, for the staff of TNB and its subsidiaries, named *Skim Potongan Gaji* (SPG) was also introduced to gather funds for the same purpose. There are a total of 516 monthly contributors, which consist of UNITEN and TNB staff, amounting to RM126,423.50.


Tabung Amanah Zakat UNITEN (TAZU), another financial arm of UNITEN, carries out the duty of the Assistant Amil of Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) which enables the University to collect and distribute Zakat in order to contribute to the development of human society. TAZU manages and regulates all matters in a transparent manner in regard to collection, administration and distribution of Zakat. In 2018, TAZU collected RM8,954,272.93 of Zakat over the counter and via staff salary deduction scheme. TAZU distributed RM3,896,068.39 to Asnaf Fakir, Miskin, Fisabilillah and Muallaf through sponsorship, subsistence, Go Kitchen programme, students development programme, scholarship, and Aidilfitri assistance for UNITEN students. Meanwhile, UNITEN staff under the same categories received special assistance such as schooling assistance for their children, pocket money and tuition fees to lessen their financial burden. Waqaf initiative launched in the year 2018 has received overwhelming supports from UNITEN staff and community with a total collection of RM92,889.90.


▼ TABUNG AMANAH ZAKAT UNITEN (TAZU)

2019: Shifting the Gear

Three years have passed. UNITEN is ready to implement its second phase of BOLD 2025. TNB has approved RM95 million OPEX for 2019-2021 for UNITEN to carry out Phase 2 of BOLD2025. With physical infrastructure updates mostly in place, UNITEN is directing its focus towards enhancing talent development in research, as well as continuing to deliver exceptional teaching and learning environment. In terms of financial sustainability, UNITEN will continue our effort to diversify revenue streams.

Talent in Research

The three professors hired under the Strategic Hires Initiatives have been leading several research groups in UNITEN, and giving training and guidance to academic staff in UNITEN in the energy fields. UNITEN aims to have 78% of its academic staff becoming principal investigators/projects leaders through knowledge sharing sessions by visiting professors, and coordinated initiatives rolled out under five research institutes namely IEPRe, IPE, ISE, IEI, IICE; together with iRMC and UNITEN's consultancy arm, UNITEN R&D Sdn. Bhd. These will lead to meeting the target of RM125 million cumulative research grants and consultancy revenue secured by 2019 (since year 2016).

Exceptional Teaching and Learning Environment

In terms of teaching and learning environment, aggressive approaches are being used to ensure all lecturers start to use BL tools in the classrooms, from beginners to advance users. TLC has also appointed BL agents among the academic staff to be guided and trained in applying BL tools until Level 4: Adaptive Learning. This could warrant more enhanced learning experiences for the students in UNITEN.

Diversification of Revenue Stream

Financial sustainability plays an important role in keeping UNITEN in a sustainable manner. Under the Business Development Department (BDD), UNITEN increases its effort to diversify income via two revenue

streams, i.e. rental on UNITEN facilities including sport facilities, auditorium, meeting rooms and seminar rooms; and training and professional courses.

The establishment of YCU, TAZU and Waqaf also contribute towards improving UNITEN financial position, channelling donations and sponsorships for the benefits of UNITEN and its students.

Increase UNITEN branding

To the world, UNITEN wants to be portrayed as a university that enables its students to change the world focusing on Energy. This is done through strategic partnerships with specific targeted schools, expanding recruitment channels locally and internationally, and aggressive marketing via mainstream and social media.

Building Resilience & Holding Tight to Core Values

For 2019, UNITEN has announced that its aspiration is "Mission Possible: Let's be together". This shows that UNITEN is confident that it can overcome all challenges by working together collectively as a team with strong culture and core values; Integrity, Customer Focus, Caring and Team Work.

All these efforts and plan for 2019 will contribute directly towards reaching UNITEN's goal of becoming a regional leader by 2020, UNITEN is set to attain its targeted ranking places in both QS Asian Ranking & THE Asia University Ranking.
